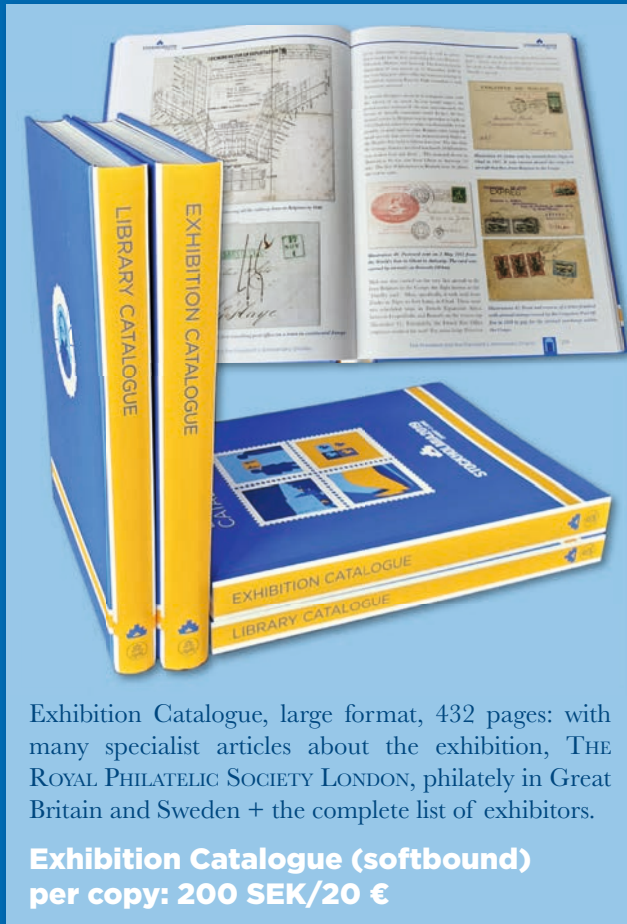

The exhibition you will meet here at Stockholm Waterfront Congress Centre, commenced its planning more than 6 years ago.
