- · The Royal Philatelic Society London, the oldest philatelic society in the world, was established in 1869 as The Philatelic Society, London. In 1896 HRH The Duke of York, son of King Edward VII, became President of the Society, an office he continued to hold until his accession to the throne as HM King George V in 1910. Permission to use the prefix Royal was granted by His Majesty King Edward VII in 1906. Following his accession King George V acted as its Patron, and in 1924 granted the Society permission to use the Royal Arms on its stationery and publications. The Royal philatelic tradition has been maintained and today the Society is honoured by the Patronage of Her Majesty The Queen. At STOCKHOLMIA 2019, a selection from The Royal Philatelic Collection, will be presented as part of Court of Honour.
- STOCKHOLMIA 2019 is an International Philatelic Exhibition with exhibits and displays from members of the Society from all over the world.

- With capacity of 2,100 frames, the exhibition is the largest Society exhibition ever held. In addition, more than 50 Trade Stand Holders, from 13 different countries are participating.

STOCKHOLM - NICE TO KNOW

It's made up of lots of islands

Stockholm was built on 14 islands, connected by 57 bridges, earning the Swedish capital the nickname »Beauty on the Water«.

There are roughly 24,000 islands in the Stockholm archipelago alone. About 150 are inhabited and most of the islands are accessible only by private boat. During summer, you should know that you can practically go swimming anywhere in the inner city, due to the closeness to water as well as wallemansrätten« (freedom to roam).

The water on tap is also often called the best in the world.

There are bicycles everywhere

With nearly 800 km of bicycle paths zig-zagging their way across Stockholm, it's no surprise that there are bikes all over the city (around 150,000 city-dwellers commute daily in the capital).


Public transport around Stockholm is genuinely excellent, with a comprehensive metro, bus and tram network.

Stockholm's Metro stations are dubbed the World's Longest Art Gallery. More than 90 of 100 stations along the 68 miles of track have been decorated with mosaics, paintings, sculptures and carvings by artists since the 1950s.

or family, you'll revel in the many opportunities to »fika«.











RDP CEREMONY THE ROLL OF DISTINGUISHED PHILATELISTS




The Roll of Distinguished Philatelists (RDP) is a prestigious international philatelic award, created by the Philatelic Congress of Great Britain in 1921. The Roll consists of pieces of parchment to which the signatories add their names. Being one of the highest and most prestigious honors in philately, the RDP recognizes achievement, research, publication and service. It was established in 1920, and in 1921, King George V was the first to sign the roll.

Set in the Grand Hôtel in the Hall of Mirrors - Spegelsalen. In this room the first Nobel Prize ceremony and banquet took place in 1901.
